## Recipe of The Month- “Texas Trash Dip”

*Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Butter a 9x13 baking dish, set aside. Heat ½ tbsp. butter in skillet and sauté ½ c. chopped onion until tender. Let cool. In bowl beat together 1 block cream cheese and 1 c. sour cream. Add this taco seasoning (2 tsp. chili powder, ½ tsp. each of paprika, cumin, coriander, and Cajun seasonings, 1 tsp. kosher salt, and ½ tsp. sugar) combine well. Mix in 2 cans of refried beans and cooked onions. Spread into baking dish. Whisk together these sauce ingredients (8oz. can tomato sauce, 1 tsp. hot sauce, 2 tsp. chili powder, 1 tsp. cumin, 1 ½ tsp. sugar, and ¼ c. water) and pour over top. Sprinkle with 1c. pepper jack cheese and 1c. cheddar cheese. Bake for 25-30 minutes.*
