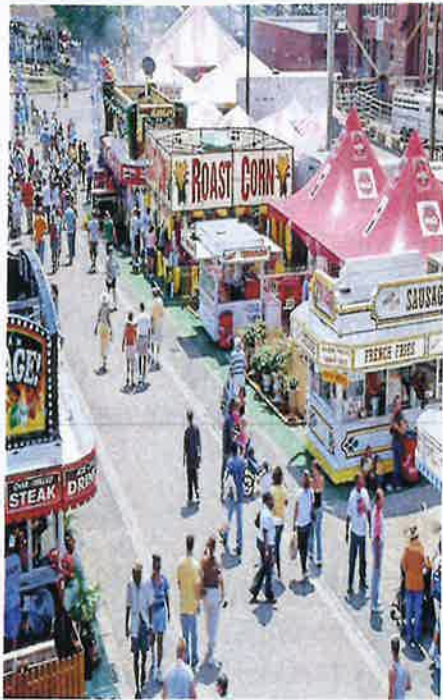

## Smores Pudding Dessert

Microwave 4 c. marshmallows and 1/4 cup milk in large microwaveable bowl on HIGH 1-1/2 min. or until marshmallows are completely melted, stirring after 1 min. Stir until mixture is well blended. Refrigerate 10 min. or until completely cooled. Meanwhile, line 9-inch square pan with plastic wrap, with ends of wrap extending over sides. Arrange 10 graham on bottom of prepared pan, breaking as necessary to fit. Add 1 cup COOL WHIP to marshmallow mixture; whisk until blended. Spread over grahams in pan. Refrigerate until ready to use. Melt 2 oz. chocolate as directed on package. Beat 1 pkg. cream cheese in large bowl with mixer until creamy. Gradually beat in 1 c. milk. Add 1 box chocolate dry pudding mix; beat 2 min. Whisk in melted chocolate and 1 cup of the remaining COOL WHIP; pour into pan. Top with remaining grahams. Refrigerate 3 hours or until firm. Meanwhile, shave remaining chocolate piece into curls. Invert dessert onto plate; remove plastic wrap and pan. Top dessert with remaining COOL WHIP, raspberries and chocolate curls.
