Recipe of the Month- Loaded Deviled Eggs!



Fill a medium-sized bowl with ice cubes and water then set aside. Meanwhile, boil a dozen eggs in a large pot. Let eggs sit for 14 minutes then remove the lid and scoop eggs into the bowl of ice water and let cool. Chop 6 slices of bacon in a food processor. Add minced bacon to a cold skillet then place over low heat and cook until crisp. Scoop bacon onto a paper towel lined plate to drain then set aside. Peel eggs then slice in half and pop yolks into a medium-sized bowl. Add 1/2c. mayonnaise, minced jalapenos, 2 tsp. vinegar, 2 tsp. mustard, smoked paprika, and steak seasoning then mix and mash with a fork until smooth. Scoop mixture into a gallon size Ziplock bag then snip the corner off and squeeze the mixture into the center of each egg half. Sprinkle each egg with steak seasoning, paprika, bacon, chives, and a jalapeno slice! Enjoy!!!
