## Recipe of the Month- Reuben Rounds

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Unfold a thawed roll of puff pastry and layer with 6 slices of swiss cheese, 6 slices of corned beef, and a 1/2 cup of drained sauerkraut. Roll up jelly roll style. Trim ends and cut crosswise in 16 slices. Lay on cookie sheet and sprinkle with carraway seeds. Bake in oven for 18-20 minutes or until golden brown. Serve with dressing and enjoy!



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
