RECIPE OF THE MONTH- **SAUSAGE HASHBROWN CASSEROLE**

Preheat oven to 375 and spray 9 x 13 pan with non-stick cooking spray. Brown 1 lb. pork sausage in skillet, over medium heat, breaking into small pieces. Drain grease and set aside. Whisk 8 eggs, 1 1/2c. heavy cream and salt, pepper, and garlic spices together. Layer ingredients in a casserole dish. Start with adding your 30oz. package of thawed hash browns, precooked sausage, layer of shredded cheddar cheese, and then pour on whisked egg mixture. Cover mixture with cream of mushroom soup and top with foil. Bake for 40 minutes, remove foil, and then bake for another twenty. Enjoy!
